## WOOLSEY FIRE REPOPULATION

**WHAT:** Additional Repopulation of Impacted Areas

**WHEN:** Tuesday, November 13, 2018  
3:00 P.M.

**WHERE:** The following areas will be opened to residents and businesses beginning at 3:00 P.M. on Tuesday afternoon:

The city of Agoura Hills will have limited areas in the Liberty Canyon area reopened today, which will include neighborhoods that are:

- South of Agoura Road
- East of Cornell Road
- West of Las Virgenes Road
- North of Mulholland Highway

\*Per Southern California Edison, sections of the city of Agoura Hills may be without power at the time of the reopening of the area.

The northern section of the unincorporated Topanga area will be reopened today. This will include neighborhoods:

- North of Viewridge Road
- South of the Los Angeles city limit
- East of Topanga Canyon Boulevard
- West of Double Ranch Road or Santa Maria Road

The southern section of the city of Malibu and unincorporated Malibu areas will also reopen today. This will include the neighborhoods which are:

- Pacific Coast Highway
- West of Coastline Drive
- East of Carbon Mesa Road
- From the ocean to the Malibu city limits with the following exceptions:
  - FULL CLOSURE at Tuna Canyon Road and Pacific Coast Highway. Evacuation orders remain in effect for neighborhoods north of Pacific Coast Highway and Tuna Canyon Road.
  - FULL CLOSURE at Topanga Canyon Boulevard. Evacuation orders remain in effect for neighborhoods north of Pacific Coast Highway and Topanga Canyon Boulevard.
  - FULL CLOSURE on Rambla Pacifico Drive 400 meters north of Pacific Coast Highway

**NOTICE: LASD personnel will be maintaining a checkpoint at Pacific Coast Highway and Coastline Drive. Only RESIDENTS of the repopulated areas in Malibu will be permitted to enter this area.**

Visit the link and enter an address for the Woolsey Fire area in the search field and press enter. You can then scroll out on the map to determine if the indicated area has a red or green background. Red indicates the area is still closed and unsafe to return. Green indicates the area is open for repopulation. In addition to the map, descriptions of the areas to be opened are provided below.

We continue to work with our public safety partners, including utility companies, building and safety officials, health officials, public works, and CalTrans to assess.

The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department will have a strong presence in the repopulated and evacuated areas for the next several days to ensure the protection of our residents and their property. All other road closures and evacuated areas for the Woolsey Fire remain in effect.

**NOTES: SAFETY MESSAGE** – The public is reminded to stay vigilant on current fire conditions. Please continue to adhere to road closures and any evacuation warnings. A

reminder to drive slowly and yield to emergency personnel in the area. There will still be smoke in the respective areas as firefighters continue firefighting operations. If at any time you feel unsafe, please call 911.

**Media Accessibility for People with Disabilities,

Federal Communication Commission rules under Section 255 of the Communications Act require telecommunications service providers to make their products and services accessible to people with disabilities, if such access is readily achievable.
